## NOTES: PLEASE READ!

1. All times are approximate: this schedule is presented as a guide only, the order of competitions will not change, but the time may be earlier or later, depending on no-shows or unforeseen delays.
2. All championships grouped together will be run concurrently, meaning all round 1's will be followed by all round 2's, e.g. prelim u/13 round 1 will be followed by open u/13 round 1, then both competitions will dance round 2.  
  
Opens: softshoe first,  
Prelims: hardshoe first.
3. All competitions will CLOSE 10 minutes before they appear on stage: this is to allow for time to sort out any situations due to no-shows that might affect the pre-assigned rotations by our tabulator Jim Montague. If you wander up to the stage just as your competition is beginning onstage, you will get the same feeling as you get when you get to the airport late and you miss your flight! Please don't be late! All check-ins will be announced at the commencement of check-in and prior to closing.
3. If your championship is not listed then this means that it has been combined with the next highest age category. All competitions listed above will be run as separate competitions. The Adult Championship will take place 30 min. after all other adult competitions have finished.
4. All Dress-Up/Dress-Down Treble Reel Competitions will take place on a separate stage between 12 noon and 2pm. Top Fashion Publication 'Vogue' will be in attendance and the fashion portion of the contest will be decided by leading Vogue model and Irish dancer Coco Rocha.
5. On the following day, Sunday April 20, you can unwind, or alternatively keep dancing, as an Apres-Feis Session from 6pm-9pm at the Water Street Restaurant, 66 Water Street, Dumbo in Brooklyn. Music by feis musicians Niall Mulligan, Conor McGuirk and Niall O'Leary!
